

# StreetPilot c340° quick reference guide

# Step 1: Mount Your c340

To ensure a tight grip, clean and dry the windshield before mounting the suction cup.



- Plug the small end of the cable into the mount and the other end in a 12-Volt receptacle in your vehicle.
- 2. Place the suction cup on the windshield.
- 3. Flip the lever back, toward the windshield.



- 4. Fit the bottom of your c340 into the cradle of the suction cup mount.
- 5. Tilt your c340 back until it snaps in place.

If necessary, use the tension knob to improve your viewing angle.

**WARNING:** This product contains a **non-user-replaceable** lithium-ion battery. Do not remove or attempt to remove the battery. Doing so could result in risk of battery fire or damage and injury.

To prevent damage and risk of fire due to high temperatures, remove the unit from the vehicle or store it out of direct sunlight. For more information, see www.garmin.com/ safety.

Check your state and local traffic laws before mounting. Currently, state laws in California and Minnesota prohibit drivers from using suction mounts on their windshields while operating motor vehicles. Other Garmin dashboard or friction mounting options should be used.

# Step 2: Configure Your c340

Press and hold the  $\bigcirc$  **Power** button on the side of the unit to turn it on. Follow the on-screen instructions to set up your c340; you only have to do this once.

# **Step 4: Follow Your Route**

Follow the route to your destination using the Map page. As you travel, your c340 guides you to your destination with voice prompts, arrows on the map, and directions at the top of the Map page. If you depart from the original route, your c340 recalculates the route and provides new route instructions.



Your route is marked with a magenta line.



Follow the arrows as you take turns.



A checkered flag marks your destination.


You can add a stop to your route. The c340 gives you directions to the stop and then to your final destination.

- 1. With a route active, go to the Menu page, and touch **Q** Where to.
- 2. Search for the extra stop.
- 3. Touch Go.
- 4. Touch **Yes** to add this stop before your destination. Or, touch **No** to make this your new final destination.

Note: You can add only one stop to your route.

## Viewing the Map Page

From the Menu page, touch **View map** to open the Map page. The position icon  $\triangle$  shows your current location. Touch buttons on the Map page to see additional information.

After you have set your Home location, you can route to it at any time by touching **Where to** > **My Locations** > **Go Home**.

## Traffic Information with an FM TMC Traffic Receiver


Using a Garmin FM TMC Traffic Receiver, your c340 can receive and use traffic information broadcast over the FM Radio Data System. For more information about Garmin FM traffic receivers, visit www.garmin.com/traffic.

#### Viewing Traffic Incidents

From the Menu page, touch reference to display a list of traffic incidents. The traffic symbols appear on the Map as well.

#### **Avoiding Traffic**

The Map page displays  $\diamond$  when there is a traffic incident on your current route or on the road on which you are traveling. To avoid a traffic incident, touch  $\diamond$ , select a traffic incident, and touch **Avoid**.



# Adjusting the Volume

To adjust the volume, turn the Volume knob, located above the **Power** button.

#### Adjusting the Backlight Brightness

- 1. From the Menu page, touch
- Touch to decrease the backlight brightness.
   Or, touch to increase the brightness.
- 3. Touch OK.

# **Resetting Your c340**

If your c340 stops responding, turn it off and back on. If this does not help, reset the c340.

- 1. Unplug the power and USB cables to remove external power.
- 2. Place your thumbnail in the groove located under the Garmin logo on the faceplate and gently pull off the faceplate.
- 3. Press the Reset button for about 3 seconds.
- 4. Connect the c340 to a power source using the power cable. The c340 should automatically turn back on and operate normally.
